



How to find the clinic at 24 Albion Place

Albion Place is a quiet road which is accessed from Derrigate; it is close to the Royal & Derrigate Theatre complex and the Northampton Filmhouse (formerly the Errol Flynn Filmhouse). The postcode for satellite navigation is NN1 1UD. The clinic is based in a terraced house which has been reconfigured for use as a clinic. The sign outside is discreet for your privacy.



Parking

There is on-road parking outside the clinic, which is payable Monday to Saturday from 8am to 6pm. Albion Place is a cul de sac; at the end of the street (towards Victoria Promenade) there is a surface car park called Albion Place Car Park, which is payable Monday to Sunday from 8am to 11.59pm. St John's multi storey car park is three minutes' walk away where you can park for up to two hours free of charge.

Please note that the clinic's central location means that parking officers are often on patrol.

The clinic

The door to the clinic is kept locked for your safety. When you arrive, please press the doorbell and someone will let you in. Please note that the clinic is within a former four storey house and thus there are flights of stairs to all but one of the treatment rooms. Outside the property there is a very short flight of steps to the front door, which are shown in the photo below. Unfortunately, this means that this clinic is not suitable for wheelchair users.



Waiting area

There is a small waiting room inside the clinic, where you may wait for your appointment. We provide drinks, magazines and tissues for your comfort. As the waiting area is not very large, it is best not to arrive too early, although we understand that you may want to arrive in good time to avoid being late.
