How to find Priory Wellbeing Centre Oxford

The Priory Wellbeing Centre Oxford is in the centre of the city. It is accessed from Bonn Square, which is adjacent to the main entrance to the Westgate (Shopping) Centre. The postcode is OX1 1LQ; however, there is nowhere to park immediately outside the clinic. Please see below for locations of Park & Ride facilities, and car parks. The sign outside is discreet for your privacy.

Parking

Park & Ride is the easiest way to get into Oxford with journey times into the City Centre up to every 10-15 minutes during busy times. There are five Park & Ride sites located around Oxfordshire:

Public transport

As well as Park & Ride, there are bus and coach routes into the city as well as trains from London, Manchester and other locations in the Midlands. The train station is a 10-15 minute walk from the clinic.

The clinic

The clinic is on the third floor of the smoked glass fronted building shown below. If you have difficulty finding us, stand with your back towards Jo Malone, L'Occitane and Comptoir Libanais and you will see the same view as shown in the photo below.

The clinic has a large waiting area with access to hot drinks and water as well as magazines for your comfort.



Access

Upon arrival at the main gate, press the intercom button to gain access to the premises. After a short flight of steps, you will reach the main door. Use the second intercom to access the building. There are stairs to the third floor; however, there is a lift between the first and third floors. If you cannot manage any steps or stairs, there is a lift which is accessible (on request by calling 01865 262080) from a locked side entrance on New Inn Hall Street.
